- 71 Morris made a motion to make a recommendation to City Council to accept Discover Lakes
- 72 preliminary plat with fees. Alvarado seconded the motion which passed unanimously.

- 80 Cash In Lieu Of Land:  $$383.00 \times 397$  lots = \$152.051.00
- 81 Pro Rata Equipment Fees:  $363.00 \times 397$  lots = 144,111.00
- 82 Morris made a motion to make a recommendation to City Council to accept this plat with
- 83 fees totaling \$296,162. Alvarado seconded the motion which passed unanimously.

- 88 Mr. Sales explained that this plat is located in Park District 17. Fees are as follows.
- 89 Cash In Lieu Of Land: \$232.00 x 265 lots = \$61,480.00
- 90 Pro Rata Equipment Fees: \$220.00 x 265 lots = \$58,300.00

- 91 Dodd made a motion to make a recommendation to City Council to accept this final plat
- 92 for Harbor Hills Addition with fees totaling \$119,780. Johnson seconded the motion
- 93 which passed unanimously.
